# FREE TREE Project

The **West Lansing Homeowners Association** has created a **Beautification Committee** to identify opportunities to make our neighbourhood more attractive and to take advantage of City programs where possible to make things happen. One of the best opportunities available is the City of Toronto's Urban Forestry division program to plant trees **free of charge** on the city street allowance. This means you could have a free beautiful tree in front of your house!

## Why is this important? Trees:

- Help improve the environmental tree canopy adding living beauty to Toronto's neighbourhoods
- Filter air pollution
- Reduce cooling and heating costs of your house
- Generate oxygen, absorbs carbon dioxide and other harmful pollutants
- Reduce storm water run-off and the cost of water treatment
- Provide habitat for birds and other fauna
- Increase property values by adding "curb appeal" to your home.

The Beautification Committee's goal is to make it easy for homeowners to request a tree, and to add value by carefully recommending species of trees that will look great on your particular street. We are very fortunate to have a Landscape Architect as a member of this volunteer Committee. Under her guidance the entire neighbourhood was surveyed and over **300 suitable spots** for trees were identified on the city street allowances. A **number of tree species** were selected for you to choose from, subject to the availability and to unique physical limitations of your property such as high voltage lines. The list of trees is shown on the back of this letter and on [www.westlansing.ca](http://www.westlansing.ca) and you can choose your favourite two trees.

We'd like to make to most of this opportunity while it's available. Collecting and submitting everyone's requests as a coordinated community initiative makes things easier for the City's Urban Forestry division, an idea fully supported by Councillor John Filion. The sooner we submit our request the better. Trees should be planted this spring or later in the fall of 2009. Scheduling of your tree for planting will be dependant on when your request is received, and the availability of the species.
